Twin Oaks Elementary School is a public English school with 516 students within the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board. We are located at 600 Lisane St. in the Fabreville district of Laval, QC. Our community encompasses many cultures and ethnicities. Our governing board held its general assembly of parents on September 13, 2022 and has conducted eight monthly meetings over the course of the 2022-2023 school year.

The governing board fulfilled its functions as prescribed in the Quebec Education Act. We voted to maintain our current Subject-Time Allocation for the 2023-2024 school year while pledging to improve the quality of French as a Second Language instruction at Twin Oaks Elementary. Our current subject-time allocation allotted at 65% English and 35% French instruction.

We approved the school's annual operating budget for the 2023-2024 school year which includes consumable, supervision and school activity fees. Our school strives to maintain fees at the lowest level possible. This year has been particularly challenging given the increased price of essentials like paper.

We have worked on the SWLSB Budget Building Process Consultation, Twin Oaks Elementary Anti-Bullying, Anti-Violence Plan, and Student Code of Conduct as well as Criteria for the Selection of Principal, Deeds of Establishment, and Enrollment Criteria, In addition, there were other consultations requested by the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board Council of Commissioners.

The governing board approved the reception of over \$290,000.00 in MEES measure grants for a variety of student learning support and activities. In addition, our Parent Participation Organization and school staff organized fundraisers to provide activities and resources for our students.
